Introducing Docman Intellisense

Intellisense dramatically improves speed and accuracy when filing letters into the patients clinical record.

Intellisense will also capture diagnosis and procedure read codes within a document and present them to the user.

Intellisense Filing

Patient Identification

Intellisense extracts patient demographic information from a document such as NHS/CHI number, forename, surname and date of birth. This information is then used to match the document with the correct patient. This removes the need for manual patient searching and significantly reduces the time taken for this process.

Document Identification

Intellisense scans the text of a document and looks for keywords and uses pre-defined templates to assign the document with an accurate and detailed description. The information captured can include clinic date, letter type, hospital, department and consultant. In addition Intellisense identifies the key information required to file a letter.

Intellisense Summarising

Read Code Identification

Having filed the document into the patients clinical record, Intellisense will search for diagnosis and procedure read codes within the document.

Intellisense will alert you when trying to add a code that is already part of that patients record, allowing it to be added as a review of that problem instead. Intellisense will also alert you when selecting a similar code to one already present in the patient record. This can be completed by clinical staff or a read coding team depending on your current workflow.

Intellisense (like most clinical systems) uses sophisticated 'Velocity' coding algorithms and relevance scoring. In short this ensures that Intellisense chooses read codes that are frequently used within your practice, ensuring accurate clinical coding for QOF.

Can my practice use Intellisense?

Intellisense is an add-on module for Docman 7. You will need one of the following clinical systems:

- EMIS LV
- EMIS PCS
- G PASS
- InPS Vision
- iSoft Synergy

Intellisense works with scanned documents as well as Microsoft Word, HTML, RTF, TXT and CSV documents. Scanned documents filed with Intellisense are automatically converted into text using Optical Character Recognition (OCR).

The Intellisense Package

Includes onsite installation and training.

The standard package includes one Intellisense filing licence, unlimited summarising, installation and training. Additional Intellisense filing licences are available.
